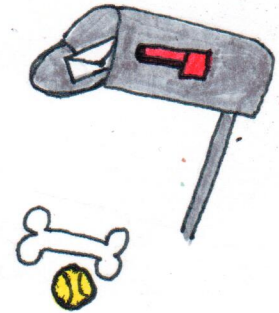


# AGE APPROPRIATE CHORES

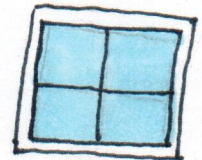
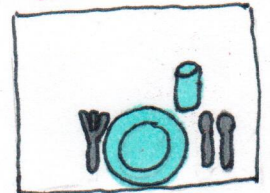
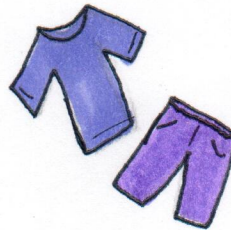
## 3-5 Years

- Pick up dog toys
- Sort socks
- set the table
- get the mail
- put dishes in sink after meals
- get dressed/undressed
- put books away
- pick up toys
- pick up sticks in yard
- get the mail
- dust with duster
- water plants
- remove sheets from bed
- make small snacks (i.e. pour crackers in dish, get string cheese)
- stir/mix ingredients in a bowl
- begin matching outfits



## 6-8 Years

- make bed
- feed and water pets
- pull some weeds in yard
- pick up toys in room
- take rolling garbage cans to curb
- vacuum carpet
- set table
- pick up pet toys
- clear dinner table
- move laundry from washer to dryer to basket
- pour drinks for meals
- clean windows or table
- brush teeth and comb hair
- pick out clothes and dress self
- unpack backpack and lunch box
- frost cupcakes or cookies



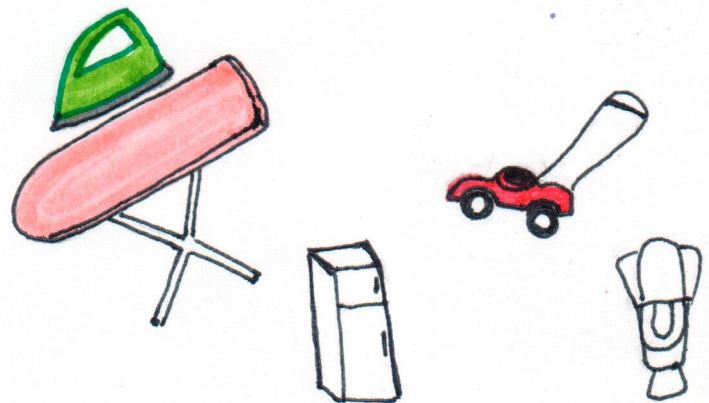
## 9-12 Years

- help bring groceries in
- put groceries away
- clean toilet
- make simple breakfast or lunch (toaster strudel, sandwiches, scrambled eggs)
- wash and dry laundry
- get garbage from all trash cans and take to main garbage can
- wash car
- do laundry (washer, dryer, fold)
- take garbage
- walk pet
- clean up pet messes in yard
- load dishwasher
- rake leaves
- sweep floors
- clean and organize bedroom



## 13-16 Years

- mow yard
- make meals using stove or oven
- clean bathtub
- empty dishwasher and put dishes away
- clean bathroom sink and toilet
- mop floors
- clean microwave or refrigerator
- fold and iron clothes
